GENERAL INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES/PARENTS

REGISTRATION & ENROLLMENT

Camp registration is first-come, first-served. A \$40 non-refundable deposit per child, per week is required at registration.

After registering, families will receive a confirmation email with a link to complete enrollment. Required camper forms include completed registration paperwork and current physical and immunization records from your child's PCP. Forms are also available at the Welcome Center if needed.

Each camp requires its own set of forms.

- ▶ Camp Apex forms: Due the first day of camp
- ▶ Gymnastics Camp forms: Due by May 1, 2026
Forms submitted after May 1 must be completed at the time of enrollment to secure placement

Full payment is due two weeks prior to the start of each camp session. Campers may not attend if payment is not paid in full. Payments may be made online, by phone, or at the Welcome Center.

YMCA COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

The YMCA is committed to making camp accessible to all families. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis and available to active YMCA members. Applications can be found at www.your-y.org/camps and must be returned with the required documentation.

DCF / SEVEN HILLS VOUCHERS

DCF and Seven Hills vouchers are accepted for Camp Apex only.

CAMP DISCOUNTS

Discounts cannot be combined with YMCA scholarships, DCF, or other vouchers.

- ▶ Full Summer Discount: Save by enrolling for the whole summer
- ▶ Sibling Discount: Save up to 15% for a second child

REFUND & TRANSFER POLICY

All camps require a \$40 non-refundable deposit per child, per week.

- ▶ Before May 1, 2026:
 - Refunds issued minus the \$40 deposit
 - Deposits may be transferred to another camp week
- ▶ After May 1, 2026:
 - Refunds granted only for medical reasons or relocation
 - Physician's note required for medical refunds

No refunds or credits will be issued after camp begins.

Families who do not notify the Y of cancellation will be charged the full camp fee. Please cancel promptly to allow campers on the waitlist to participate.

SAFETY IS OUR #1 PRIORITY!

- ▶ All camp staff and volunteers are CORI, SORI and background checked.
- ▶ We complete reference checks for each staff member including professional and personal references.
- ▶ All staff are first aid and CPR certified.
- ▶ Staff members are required to attend 30+ hours of training as well as mandatory annual child abuse prevention, bullying prevention, and concussion trainings.
- ▶ We are licensed and comply with all Department of Public Health regulations.
- ▶ We swim evaluate all new swimmers at the start of each session. We provide flotation devices to campers who require them.
- ▶ All swimmers **must pass a deep end test before** they are allowed to move beyond shallow water.
- ▶ Our pools are always guarded by certified lifeguards during camp hours.
- ▶ Counselors perform face counts and take attendance numerous times throughout the day and at every transition.
- ▶ We are diligent with sunblock application and bug spray throughout the day.
- ▶ Campers are only released to authorized adults at pick-up.
- ▶ All camps comply with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and are licensed by local boards of health.
